# COMPREHENSIVE REHABILITATION SERVICES

Rehabilitation professionals at Ministry Health Care take the time to get to know patients and work with a multi-disciplinary team to provide comprehensive services. Our facilities provide Physical Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Speech Language and Sports Medicine services. Rehabilitation professionals work together with patients of all ages with varying functional limitations. As a Ministry employee you are surrounded by a supportive network of highly qualified and licensed professionals working toward a common goal, the patient.

The Rehabilitation Professionals at Ministry Health Care will:

- Evaluate inpatients and outpatients in relation to their diagnosis. Evaluations are comprehensive, timely, and documented clearly and concisely.
- Formulate a treatment plan which is patient focused and outcome relevant to the actual and potential health problems of the patient.
- Initiate, coordinate, and communicate collaborative efforts among health team members to learn as much as possible about the patient.



# The Rehabilitation Facilities at Ministry Health Care:

Our various facilities include:

- **Ministry Saint Michael's Hospital** in Stevens Point, Wisconsin. Primarily an outpatient orthopedic setting with opportunity to work inpatient acute care. Sub-specialization opportunities including Lymphedema, Pediatrics, and Vestibular. Includes a strong Sports Medicine program.
- **Ministry Saint Joseph's Hospital** in Marshfield, Wisconsin Level II trauma center with inpatient cases. Twenty-one bed inpatient accredited rehabilitation unit with stroke specialty program onsite. Specialty care in Pediatrics, Cancer Treatment, Neurosciences, orthopedics and hospital rehabilitation.
- **Ministry Sacred Heart Hospital** in Tomahawk and **Ministry Saint Mary's Hospital** in Rhinelander, Wisconsin sub-specialties in Lymphedema, Pediatrics, Urinary Incontinence, Scoliosis, Sports Medicine and Vestibular. Department building shared with local YMCA with access to all equipment. Very strong Sports Med program with support of LAT/ATC on staff.
- **Ministry Our Lady of Victory Hospital** in Stanley, Wisconsin. Mostly outpatient setting with some acute care possibilities. Critical access hospital with a swing bed population as well. Patient centered, community minded facility with chances to grow practice with a variety of patients.
- **Howard Young Medical Center** in Woodruff, Wisconsin. High outpatient orthopedic population. Previously named a top 100 Orthopedic Hospital. Opportunities to specialize in various areas. Current staff include McKenzie Certified Therapist, Pilates Certified Therapist, NDT Certified Therapist and Advanced Training in Aquatic Therapy.
- **Ministry Eagle River Memorial Hospital** in Eagle River, Wisconsin. Critical Access facility with 25 beds. The Rehabilitation Department includes strong acute care and swing bed services, supplemented with outpatient rehabilitation services.

- **Ministry Good Samaritan Health Center** in Merrill, Wisconsin. Mostly out-patient facility with opportunity for acute care. Offers industrial medicine services. Opportunity to build practice in various settings for generalist rehab staff.
- **Ministry Door County Medical Center** in Sturgeon Bay, Wisconsin. Training for therapists in various settings including outpatient, inpatient, skilled nursing facility, school system and home health. Progressive facility treating various diagnoses including orthopedic, neurological, and sports medicine.
- **Ministry Home Care**, various locations in Wisconsin. Therapy services in patients' homes or wherever care is requested. Several agencies named as Elite Homecare agencies by OCS.
