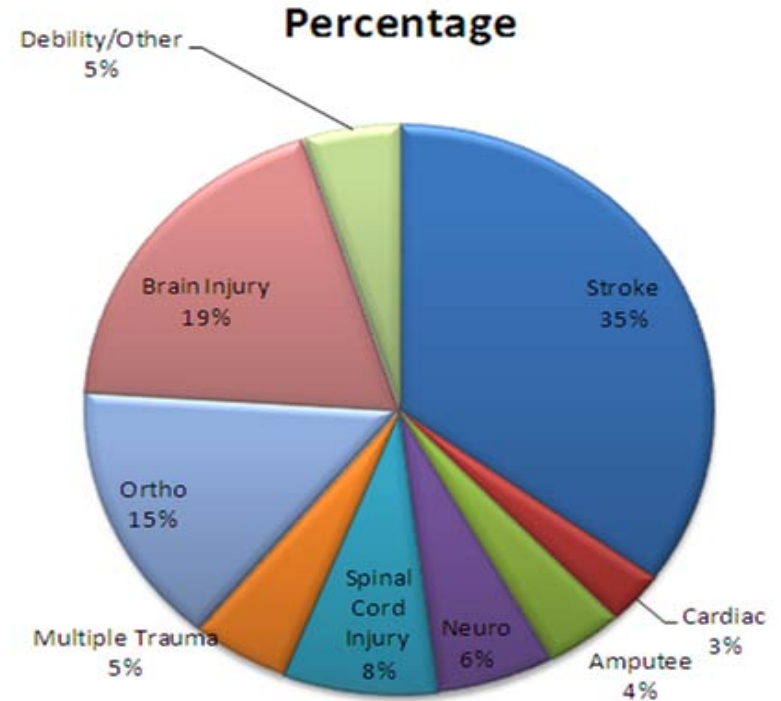

Just the Facts:

The following information reflects the time frame of January 1, 2011- December 31, 2011.

- Admissions: 298
- Average Age: 64 (Range from 20 to 98 years of age)
- From SJH: 97%
- Outside SJH: 3%

Therapy is scheduled Monday through Saturday. Patients can expect to receive 3 hours of therapy daily (spread throughout the day) on at least five out of seven days.

Scope of Service

The 21-bed Rehabilitation Center provides nursing and rehabilitation care to patients with physical and cognitive deficits as a result of a variety of disease processes. These include but are not limited to stroke, spinal cord injury, brain injury (traumatic/non-traumatic), multiple trauma, amputation, post-joint replacement, neurological conditions (multiple sclerosis, Parkinson's disease, etc.) and other neurological, orthopedic and medical conditions resulting in functional deficits impairing independence.

Staffing is provided 24 hours per day by nursing personnel (RN's, LPN's, CNA's, HUC's). Therapy services are provided Monday through Saturday, with limited availability on Sunday. Therapy services include physical, occupational and recreational therapy, with speech therapy being provided through an arrangement with the Marshfield Clinic.

The interdisciplinary staff of the Rehab Center is devoted to providing rehabilitative care and education to patients and their support systems. Education of the patient and support system regarding adaptive techniques/equipment, medication and diagnoses is an integral component of the Rehab process.
